**A few Halloween safety tips:**

1. Cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks.
2. Decorate costumes and bags with reflective tape or stickers and, if possible, choose light colors.
3. Children under the age of 12 should not be alone at night without adult supervision. If kids are mature enough to be out without supervision, they should stick to familiar areas that are well lit and trick-or-treat in groups.
4. Slow down and be especially alert in residential neighborhoods. Children are excited on Halloween and may move in unpredictable ways.
